

**THE BIG BAND SOUND AT HUNT'S LANDING . . . plus Johnstown & Lehigh Valley**

On this new tour package you'll be visiting a number of cities and towns in the eastern portion of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as well as other places in Allentown (originally founded by German settlers), Johnstown and parts of the Lehigh Valley. We'll be staying at the 3-Diamond Inn at Hunt's Landing (located on a 30 acre site bordered by the pristine Delaware River) for two nights and the third nights at the Sands Casino & Resort.



We'll be visiting the Steamtown National Historic Site. You'll have the opportunity to get "up close and personal" with these historic trains, the roandhouse, the special exhibits or the movie "Steel and Steam". During another visit, we'll be visiting the engineering marvel that is synonymous with Johnstown and the great floods, the Johnstown Inclined Plane. Constructed by a predecessor of Bethlehem Steel after the 1889 flood, this has continued to be used as recently as 1977 to move people and vehicles to safety when flood waters once again struck. It is one of the longest and steepest hoists in the world and one of the few transportation systems of its kind still in existence. A few blocks away we will also be stopping at the Flood Museum.

We have scheduled this tour so that you'll be there for their Big Band Music Day that brings so many "day trippers" from the area to the hotel. That day there will be a hot breakfast buffet, choices of visiting the gift shop, bingo or card playing, an "open bar" with your favorite refreshments, and followed by an early afternoon of music of the Big Band Era, dancing and activities. When it gets to be about 2:30 pm we'll be having a dinner buffet. The rest of the afternoon and evening will be yours to rest and relax.

The next morning we'll include visits to Allentown and Bethlehem. We'll be having lunch at an Irish Pub and visiting a museum of transportation in a beautiful two-story building in the heart of town. We'll also be seeing the unique Steelworks, located in the reclaimed portion of the old Bethlehem Steel Works, not far from the beautiful new Sands Casino & Resort where we are staying. At night you'll be able to see the intricate pipes and tanks, illuminated by red spotlights from below, simulating the long-extinguished furnaces of the steel mill which opened in 1850. The steel mill has not sat idle over the years and has been used as a backdrop in the movie "Transformers 2". Inside the casino the steel industry theme is also present with lots of bolts and beams. From the ceiling, there are hundreds of dangling bright orange rods, resembling the red hot metal ready to be poured at the mill. As always, you'll be getting bonuses for your enjoyment at this casino. Six meals, the open bar at the hotel and a \$20 meal voucher and a bonus at the Sands are included.
