This one-day tour to the National Museum of the U.S. Air Force starts with a luncheon in their Valkyrie Cafe and then seeing close-up the exciting planes that made history, including those hanging above us as if "flying overhead". Prepare to have a high-flying time during today's tour. There are numerous galleries including "The Early Years", "World War II", "Korean War" and many more including one devoted to "R & D".

Near Dayton, in Fairborn, Ohio, this is the oldest and largest military aircraft museum. It's a "must see" for any enthusiast and anyone else, housing over 300 aircraft and missiles. We'll be enjoying the IMAX production (anticipated to be "Fighter Pilot") which we've included to make this an even more interesting visit. The air base is home to several presidential aircraft including the famous VC-137C #26000 (see photo) and the VC-121E Columbine III as well as several non-presidential aircraft.
