

PITTSBURGH RIVERBOAT CRUISIN' . . . upscale dining at the Grand Concourse

This tour includes a beautiful cruise after dining at the fabulous Grand Concourse Restaurant in historic Station Square. This former P&LE Railroad Station is an architectural wonder. During the summer afternoon cruise you can hear the captain's narration of all the glorious city sites including two inclines (the Duquesne and Monongahela). The historic Duquesne Incline, with its 1877 cable cars, is our next stop; the cars travel slowly on the mountain for a great view. With a Medicare card, there is no admission onto the Incline; without the card, the charge is approximately \$3.50, paid by the individual. This year's tour has been expanded with a Pittsburgh Guide that will accompany you up Mount Washington and through Greater Pittsburgh. A similar tour is offered on Thursday, October 4th.
