

NIAGARA FALLS, USA . . . Explore the Roar . . . Formed 13,000 Years Ago

This tour travels to Niagara Falls, New York . . . better known by some as “Niagara USA”. Did you know the Niagara Falls State Park is America’s oldest state park, established in 1885? Best of all, no passport is needed since we will not be crossing over the U.S. - Canadian border, staying within New York State the entire time.

We’ll be seeing the majestic Falls, dining at a popular restaurant, seeing Goat Island, visiting the New York Power Authority’s Project Power Vista (a state of the art exhibit on energy, history and the environment) and enjoying a trip on the Maid of the Mist as we “Explore the Roar” of Niagara Falls, formed in 11,000 B.C. when the last glaciers receded.



This scenic boat trip of the Falls, aboard the Maid of the Mist, is a spectacular half-hour ride, creating a memory of a lifetime. 100,000 cubic feet of water flows over the Falls every second with the rest of the water being diverted to generators to make Niagara Falls the largest producer of electric power in the world.
