

**LAKE ERIE ISLAND HOPPING CRUISE . . . Put-In-Bay & Kelley's Island, Goodtime I Buffet**

This tour includes visits, by boat, to both Kelley's Island and Put-In-Bay on South Bass Island. Here's a full day of fun and activities as we depart Jackson Street Dock for a 40-mile all-day "Island Hopping Cruise" aboard the Goodtime I. It's a "sleek vessel", originally built for ocean-going cruises and capable of carrying up to 355 passengers. From our ship we'll be seeing Catawba, Marblehead, Lakeside, Middle Bass and other islands including Johnson's Island - a Confederate prison camp during the Civil War. We'll have an hour on Kelley's Island which is Lake Erie's largest U.S. Territory and home of Glacial Grooves created when the Glacier cut through this area as well as Inscription Rock. But this is just the start of places we'll be seeing.

A luncheon buffet will be served on the ship as we cruise from Kelley's Island to Downtown Put-In-Bay. You will have several hours on Put-In-Bay (South Bass Island) to visit the 352-foot Perry Monument, the Perry's Victory Visitors Center to see the impressive video "War of 1812 and the Battle of Lake Erie", the wineries and of course the ever-popular fudge shops. You might even want to visit the Boardwalk who is home of some of the best lobster bisque, or one of the popular entertainment places. A great tour for all ages since we generally plan this tour to coincide with "Island Fest Weekend" on Kelley's Island and "Christmas in July" on Put-In-Bay.
