

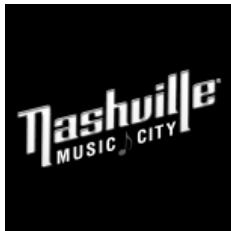
NASHVILLE FALL TOUR, FOUR SHOWS & TENNESSEE RIVER SHOWBOAT
