We've scheduled this tour so that you'll be celebrating Oktoberfest in the Ober Gatlinburg Restaurant. Savor authentic German cuisine and your favorite beverage as the Bavarian Oompah band performs while you dine. During the last evening of this tour, we've included the Hatfield & McCoy Dinner Feud. Opened in the spring of 2011, its rich in Appalachian heritage and serves up some great food. And, by the way, the theater lobby features the largest moonshine still in the world and also highlights the history of the mountain people and everyday life back in the hills . . . while making you laugh at the same time.
