This year we are inviting you to join us on an extended package with two days of cruising on the Mississippi River. We'll be departing LeClaire (just north of the Quad Cities) on the first day of a 166-mile roundtrip cruise aboard the Riverboat Twilight, to the Port of Dubuque (Iowa's oldest city), where we'll be staying at the Grand Harbor Resort which is located adjacent to Diamond Jo Casino. You'll have time to shop, browse or visit the stores and museum of this historic river town.

The Twilight is an elegant and quiet vessel as she cruises through the water. It's one of the most richly appointed riverboats in a hundred years and features three decks with Victorian steamboat architecture, both inside and out. There are comfortable dining salons and sun decks with lounge chairs to sightsee or to "catch a snooze" in the sun.



Your cruise portion also includes:

- Morning and afternoon snacks including sweet rolls, fresh fruit and tasty treats.
- Lunches and dinners during the cruise. Each day the chef aboard the Twilight takes pride in maintaining the river's grand tradition of sumptuous meals with entrees such as chicken, fish and prime rib . . . all the way through specialty desserts.
- Live entertainment including musicians and storytellers (such as "Mark Twain").
- Admission and visits in Dubuque include the National Mississippi River Museum, and complimentary shuttles to area attractions that will be welcoming you.

We've selected the fall foliage season for the dramatic show put on by the hundreds of plant life varieties along the Mississippi River Valley. This is also a nature habitat for many rare species and have been advised that the crew has been seeing 20 to 30 bald eagles on a typical cruise. We will also be staying two nights at the Isle Resort & Casino. This year's tour has been expanded to include a visit to the Middlebury, Indiana region for a family-style dinner, complete with a slice of delicious freshly-made pie. Nine meals are now included for 2012 . . . plus plenty of snacks throughout the day as we cruise the scenic Mississippi River.
