You've been asking for a package that includes rooms on Mackinac Island, a beautiful area where transportation is typically by horse carriage, bicycle or by foot. We'll be staying right along the main street of town. Breakfast is included at the hotel and dinner will be in their Goodfellows Restaurant. We've included the horse-carriage tour of the Island so you'll be seeing all that it offers, ferry service from the Mainland and time for those wishing to partake in the buffet at the Grand Hotel. There will be plenty of opportunities to visit the shops in the downtown area as well as places that make great fudge . . . to take home to those who missed out on this tour. You'll probably figure out why visitors to the Island are sometimes referred to as "fudgies".

This tour also includes an afternoon and evening at the Thunder Bay Resort. The buffet breakfast will be served in their Clubhouse Grill and dinner, with wine tasting, will be in their beautiful new log cabin. But it will be their five-course gourmet dinner will be memorable being prepared before your eyes on wood-fired stoves. We'll be traveling to this beautiful building on a carriage pulled by two giant draft horses.
