2-ISLAND HOPPING LUNCH-CRUISE WITH PUT-IN-BAY & KELLEYS ISLAND SAT JULY 11, 2026

Departures, as applic: Beachwood/Orange, Independence, Middleburg Hts, North Olmsted, Elyria.

A leisurely cruise is certainly not "out of your reach" this summer. Today we will depart the dock and cruise Lake Erie to Kelleys Island (originally occupied by the British) and South Bass Island (home of the resort village of Put-In-Bay). Enjoy some "fun in the sun" on this "Island Hopping Cruise", seeing Catawba, Marblehead and Lakeside along the way.



Kelleys Island is home to both the Inscription Rock and the Glacial Grooves, these are the largest grooves in the world, scoured into solid limestone bedrock about 18,000 years ago by the great ice sheet which covered a portion of North America. Today, a trough that is 400-feet long, 35-feet wide and up to 10-feet deep remains after the ice, which was hundreds of feet thick, carved out this area and the entire Lake Erie basin. Marine fossils have been discovered that date back 350 to 400 million years. You can generally rent a golf cart upon our arrival at the islands, based on availability.

An onboard picnic-style luncheon will be provided as we cruise to Put-In-Bay. You'll be a part of history as we dock in the same bay that played an important role in the War of 1812 and was the "home base" of Oliver Hazard Perry in the "Battle of Lake Erie", sometimes called the "Battle of Put-In-Bay". Here the nine vessels of the United States Navy defeated and captured six vessels of the British Navy, allowing America to take control of the lake. This is where the slogan began, "We have met the enemy, and they are ours". Your Tour Director and Driver are including a Tram Tour that meets us on South Bass Island.

You will have time to visit Perry's Victory & International Peace Memorial, rising 352 feet over Lake Erie or, perhaps, enjoy an "adult beverage" or some homemade fudge at one of the "afternoon shows". Feel free to visit Heineman Winery & Crystal Cave, the Car Museum or enjoy an Island tradition since 1917, the Kimberly Carousel along Delaware Avenue.
