STERNWHEELER CRUISE ON THE MUSKINGUM CRUISING, DINING AND A GIFT TO TAKE HOME!

The mighty Muskingum River travels over a hundred miles through scenic hill country. The rich floodplains along the river provide suitable conditions for walnut, elm, cotton-wood and sycamore trees. What could be a better way to spend a couple of hours today than aboard the Lorena Sternwheeler, cruising the Muskingum River? This is a good-sized vessel that is 104-foot-long, almost twice the length of our motorcoach, and 17 feet wide and departs Zane's Landing. Muskingum County is named after an Indian term meaning "near the river".



Did you know that Zanesville is home to a historic Y-shaped three-way bridge that spans the confluence of the Licking and Muskingum Rivers? Even fewer people may know that in the 1960s and 1970s, one of the first Great Day! Tours offices was located adjacent to the bridge on Main Street.

As our passengers have come to expect, there will be a hearty luncheon today and then, for a unique experience, we will be visiting Hartstone Ohio

Stoneware Factory Outlet, one of America's last remaining commercial pottery manufacturers, operating in a town that used to be the "Pottery Capital of the World".

The company now offers over two hundred items. After being made, each piece is fired at 2,200 degrees, then processed through a kiln cycle (which heats and cools) for roughly 18 hours.
