Departures, as applic: No. Olmsted, Middleburg Hts, Independence, Beachwood/Orange.

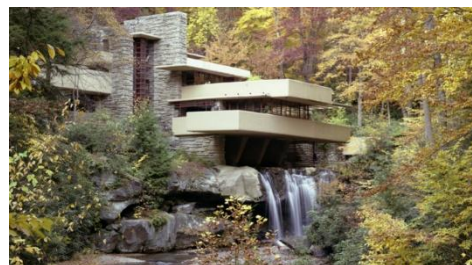


We've scheduled this tour during July, shortly after we and our countrymen celebrate our independence on the National Day of the United States, commonly known as the Fourth of July. This year it takes on a "Special Meaning" as we recognize America's 250th Anniversary. But even now, many years after July 4, 1776, events have still called upon citizens like those brave passengers aboard United Flight 93 after calling out "Let's Roll" as they fought the on-board terrorists before their plane crashed near Shanksville, Pennsylvania.

The people who lived in this area used the 4th as a tribute to those who prevented this flight from reaching its intended destination. We will be visiting the National Park Service's Flight 93 Memorial & Visitors Center today which honors the forty passengers and crew members who fought back on September 11th, 2001, to thwart the attack on the U.S. Capitol.

Our luncheon today will be at a historic restaurant that apparently was not in agreement with the country's position on Prohibition. Here, during those (supposedly) "dry years", gentlemen would bring their friends here and they would enjoy "tea" (wink, wink) served in teapots.

Following a hearty meal, we will be visiting Fallingwater, one of the most unique homes in the world . . . a home that took people just as unique to make it happen. It was designed and built for the Kaufmann family of department store fame. Here, Frank Lloyd Wright, a fellow best known for his "pork pie hat", was brought in as the designer of one of the greatest architectural triumphs of the 20th century. The structure seemingly boasts that it will "change the way you see both nature and the world" . . . tying into the somewhat similar situation of September 11th which forever changed the world, in a totally different way. There are a number of steps so we do recommend comfortable, flat shoes. One of the features of the house is that it is "dramatically sited over a waterfall", giving the appearance of not standing on solid ground as it reaches out over that 30-foot waterfall.
