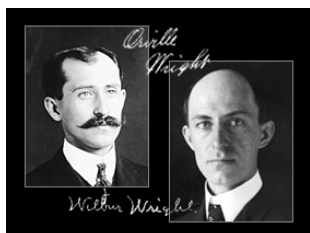
AMERICA'S 250TH - NATIONAL AIR MUSEUM, WRIGHT PATTERSON AFB SAT JULY 18, 2026

We are offering this tour to the National Museum of the United States Air Force at Wright Patterson Air Force Base as another tour in our America's "250th" Series! The Museum, which opened in 1971, is located at the largest military base operated by the Air Force in the U.S. The displays chronicle military aviation history and boast more than 360 aerospace vehicles and missiles, many of them being rare or one-of-a-kind, along with thousands of historical items and "*powerful sensory exhibits*". The

Presidential Aircraft display has been relocated into the main museum and is spectacular, with aircraft as large as the Boeing 707 "*Air Force One*". It's the world's largest and oldest military aviation museum.



You'll be connecting with the legacy of the Wright Brothers and how it led to today's stealth and precision technology. Keep in mind, their original bicycle shop, turned airplane workshop was not too far from where we will be today.
