The Maritimes are made up of the Canadian provinces of Prince Edward Island, Nova Scotia and New Brunswick. The region has both islands and peninsulas, offering dramatic views and experiences of a lifetime as they blend in with the Appalachian Highlands and the Atlantic Ocean. Over the twelve days of this tour, we will be seeing history, sites and landscapes in a package that includes twenty-three wonderful meals.

Here you will see the statue of Evangeline, the heroine immortalized by Henry Wadsworth Longfellow. This evening, once we arrive in Halifax, is yours to enjoy.

Friday – After Breakfast this morning, explore the weathered granite cliffs and artistic charm of Peggy's cove. Returning to Halifax, our Local Guide will take us on a tour of the famous Halifax Citadel while also showing

us the cemetery where many of the Titanic Victims were laid to rest. Enjoy the vibrant blooms of the Halifax Public Gardens before our scenic dinner cruise this evening.

Saturday – Rolling Hills and charming rural landscapes make up our morning as we travel to Cape Breton Island. Learn some of the rich cultural heritage with a stop at the Alexander Graham Bell National Historic Site, showcasing his life and numerous experiments. Dinner is included this evening.

Sunday – Experience one of North America's "Most Scenic Drives". The Cabot Trail. We will make a few stops along the way to indulge in some local cuisine as well as admire the ever-changing landscape of the region!

Monday – Say farewell to Cape Breton Island as we board the ferry to Prince Edward Island. A Local Guide will meet the group upon arrival for a guided tour Charlottetown, the "Birthplace of Confederation". This evening we hope you enjoy the authentic lobster supper – a must-try local tradition!

Tuesday – Today our tour will take us to one of the more famous literary settings, the Green Gables House. Made famous by L.M. Montgomery's novel "Anne of Green Gables". Later, we will see the optical illusion on Magnetic Hill and the incredible power of nature at the Reversing Falls, where the Bay of Fundy's high tides reverse the flow of the Saint John River!



Wednesday – Crossing the border back into the United States we journey south through scenic Maine with a Local Guide before checking into our hotel accommodations in South Portland.

Thursday – We depart, after saying Good-Bye to our Guide, to begin our drive home, with stops enroute. Our ride today will have us stopping in Central New York State for a leisurely dinner before checking in to our hotel for the night.

Friday – At the time announced after breakfast, we will begin our final leg home stopping for a lovely lunch at a most popular restaurant in DePew, New York, full of the memories we have from our wonderful time in Nova Scotia and the Maritimes.
