Dearborn's "The Henry Ford", is made up of the Henry Ford Museum and Greenfield Village. Named after its founder Henry Ford, it has become a "National Treasure" ... a major influencer over a number of years in our Country's History. As the nation commemorates its 250TH Anniversary, The Henry Ford offers 250 acres of special programming, new exhibitions, exciting events and more to highlight the history of American innovation. The yearlong series explores how creativity and ingenuity have sparked change across centuries of American life and how they continue to shape the future we all share, a reason why we have continued to offer it for so many years since it is fascinating to virtually every age group and individual.

The Museum preserves history of automobiles, trucks, powerful steam locomotives and Americana, in general. Exhibits include President Kennedy's Inaugural limousine, and the chair Abraham Lincoln was sitting in at Ford's Theatre. There is even a replica of the first McDonald's Restaurant with its "Golden Arches".



Greenfield Village is the largest museum of its type in the country with over a hundred historic buildings. In the Village, you will have a chance to ride in a Model T or in a real steam-powered locomotive! If you're hungry, try Eagle Tavern, enjoy meals set in 1850 accompanied by tavern owner Calvin Wood and wife Harriet Wood; additional charges may apply.

In the Village, experience the sights and sounds of America's growth, brimming with 250 years of American ingenuity and drive, serving as a living reminder that anything is possible. Step foot in the lab where Thomas Edison had his "lightbulb moment" or the workshop where the Wright brothers taught us to reach for the sky. New this year, The Jackson Home, a unique time capsule documenting the Selma to Montgomery march.
