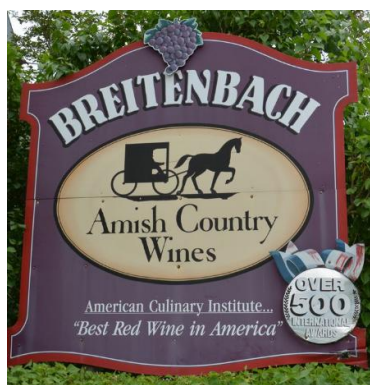


Great Day! Scheduled Tour Summary

GOING SWISS -- TWO WINERIES & TASTING TUE SEPT 15, 2026
WITH A PRIZE DRAWING OR TWO ALONG THE WAY!

Departures, as applic: Parma/Cleeland West, Middleburg Hts, Independence, Beachwood/Orange, Macedonia.

This tour travels to "*The Little Switzerland of Ohio*" where we will be visiting two of the popular wineries to enjoy tastings, a glass or two of wine and, of course, some appetizers such as assorted cheeses also produced in the region. These "wine experiences" will be before and after our luncheon today.



Our first stop today will be at a Wine Cellar on the outskirts of Sugarcreek. Its name is German, translating into "*bright or broad stream*", the same name as the waterway that runs through the winery grounds. When it first opened, the initial production was just 1,500 gallons of grape and fruit wine. After several expansions, this Wine Cellar now produces over 40 varieties of grape and fruit wines that total over 150,000 gallons annually. As important as the wine itself, this winery provides visitors with a beautiful, peaceful setting. With so many wines available, there is a wine for everyone, from connoisseurs, to those who have never visited a vineyard before. During the day, there will be several bottles of wine given as prizes

in onboard drawings.

Our mid-day luncheon will be at the Dutch Valley Complex with shopping opportunities, a bakery and even a shop featuring locally prepared meats, and keeping with the theme of this tour, locally produced cheese. At the time announced by your Tour Director, we will be visiting the Swiss Heritage Winery and the Broad Run Cheese house. There will be time to explore the newest winery area that features vaulted ceilings, a stone fireplace, a patio & deck and windows to view the wine production.

Keeping with the theme of this one-day tour, we will be traveling into Downtown Sugarcreek, which demonstrates the hospitality of Ohio's "*Little Switzerland*" as we see the beautiful Glockenspiel, with time for shopping at the Swiss Village Bulk Store. This store has all the traditional bulk foods and spices you would expect to find in local stores but probably have quite a variety to select from, including baking essentials to seasonings.
