The annual Pumpkin Festival, held in Circleville, Ohio, began back in 1903. It started out quite small back then, primarily with a display of carved Jack-O-Lanterns along the town's sidewalk. One merchant, who was also the mayor, announced that his



display was "*The Pumpkin Show*". Gradually, as other merchants and residents joined in during the following years, it grew in size, interest and attendance. During the 1905 show they even invested in bringing in a merry-go-round, placing it at a prominent intersection in the downtown area.

Over the years an organization was formed, made up of volunteers and the mayor, of course, resolving to have an annually held Pumpkin Show. At this time, the number of displays and activities began to expand, promoting the interests of both the city and the county.

It grew each year, gradually becoming the sixth largest festival in the United States with an annual attendance of over 300,000 persons during its four days of the celebration. Last year's scheduled festivities available that day included:

- All Day, The Giant Pumpkin Carving Demonstration.
- All Day, Eyes of Freedom at Memory Hall.
- Brian Wiskittle Acoustics and KaTanya Brewer of Sidewalk Serenades.
- Enjoy the music of Jonny Warner, Entertainer.
- Craft Demonstration at Bobblin Miller Quilt Basket.
- The Parade and Little Miss Pumpkin Show.
- Anna Allen Corn Husk Doll.
