CHERRY BLOSSOMS AT THEIR PEAK IN D.C. WED-FRI MARCH 24-26, 2027

Departures, as applic: Elyria, N. Olmsted, Middleburg Hts, Independence, Beachwood/Orange, Macedonia.

The best time to see cherry blossoms at their “peak” in Washington, D.C. is most typically around the last week of March through the first week of April, give or take a week either way, and should be even more enjoyable, with time to view the colors of the season and to enjoy the food that our staff has planned.

The history of these Cherry Blossoms dates to 1912 when the city received a gift of 3,000 colorful trees from the Mayor of Tokyo; to reciprocate, the city gave him flowering Dogwood Trees. By 1935 the trees fully bloomed, eventually becoming D.C.’s most popular Springtime event with its spectacular pink blossoms and typically lovely Spring weather. For America’s 250th Birthday in 2026, Japan extended another gift of 250 more Cherry Blossoms in remembrance of the friendship our two countries share.



While our tours to the Nation’s Capital have remained popular over the years, this three-day tour package should be even more enjoyable, with time to view the colors of the season, the upgraded meal selections and the activities we have planned.

Great food has been a “hallmark” for our sixty-three years, and this tour is no different. Meals include popular restaurants such as dinner in the Famous Fish Market; located in Old Town Alexandria. This restaurant opened over fifty years ago in a building that dates to the Civil War. This historic neighborhood; with its cobblestone streets, takes the visitors to a time reminiscent of its early days. This neighborhood cornerstone is known for its casual nautical vibe.

Another evening, one of the traditions our passengers have come to expect will have us dining at Tony and Joes. This waterfront restaurant along the boardwalk, with its patio bar, allows dining with stunning views of the Kennedy Center and Key Bridge (aka The Francis Scott Key Bridge) that connects Georgetown and Washington D.C. to the Commonwealth of Virginia.
