HISTORIC HARBORS ADVENTURE: EXPLORING CAPE COD & NANTUCKET WITH 3 NIGHTS IN HYANNIS!!! MON-SAT JULY 5-10, 2027

This comprehensive package includes Provincetown (at the very tip of the Cape) and the Island of Nantucket, with homes valued as high as \$50 Million. Residents have included folks like Kourtney Kardashian, Ben Stiller, James Franco, Drew Barrymore and Jenna Dewan. The memories of the beautiful and historic places and scenery will stay in your heart and mind for many years to come.

- This Summer Tour includes the Best of New England . . . Cape Cod, Nantucket Island, Plymouth and Boston!!!
- While all of our rooms will be at the Holiday Inn Hyannis, where one of our dinners and breakfast each morning are included, we also have one night at a Casino Resort as we travel to Massachusetts. Here, dinner greets us on arrival along with our bonus packet and, before we depart, a hearty breakfast.



- One of several small villages we will be visiting dates back to the mid-1850s and was the home of United States President Millard Fillmore.
- The tour includes a visit to Plymouth, Massachusetts (where, in 1620, the Pilgrims arrived from England aboard the *Mayflower* to find a new life). Be sure to have your camera, or camera-phone, with you during this “*photo op*” of the location where the *Mayflower* landed with its 102 passengers and 30 crew members. Did you know that you just might be seeing some of your family history here since it has been determined that thirty-million Americans can trace their roots to these 132 arriving people.
- During our tour of the picturesque Cape, we will be traveling along the Old Kings Highway, a scenic byway winding through centuries of Cape Cod history, typically viewing sites such as the John F. Kennedy Memorial Plaza and St. Francis Xavier Church. Now known as Route 6A it is considered one of America’s most iconic byways and “comprises the largest contiguous historic district in the country”. Our Cape Cod Guide will be pointing out four hundred years of architecture reflected in the buildings they pass along the roadway, including historic sites, sea captains’ homes, restored inns, churches and antique shops.

- Provincetown, at the “Tip of the Cape” is the most-visited part of Cape Cod and, because of this, we have allowed time to explore, shop or enjoy lunch midday Thursday. Originally settled by the Portuguese, it eventually became home to many fishermen and whalers, eventually attracting many authors and artists. For those enjoying seafood, this area offers some of the best you will find, including fried clams and fresh lobster rolls . . . and are they ever yummy!
- Another day, we will be departing from the Hyannis dock aboard a Hy-Line Cruise boat over to one of the most beautiful destinations in New England, Nantucket Island, with a long history of whaling, which made it one of the most lucrative industries in the country. Needless to say, every captain on Nantucket had a “tale worth telling”. The Island is quaint, being about fifteen miles in length with beautiful beaches and some of its gorgeous homes valued at prices up to \$50 Million. When you are here you will be able to see why the name Nantucket translates to “*The Faraway Land*” as the native tribes called it. Nantucket is unique with art galleries, a picturesque harbor, and museums. It is also renowned for its cobblestone streets, high-end dining establishments and luxurious hotels; downtown Nantucket is a haven for boutique shops which typically attract a number of our passengers. Admissions are included this year at the Nantucket Whaling Museum.
- During our day in Boston, nicknamed “*Beantown*”. You just might be learning how this city, founded in 1630, got that moniker . . . which came about when the Puritans would cook large kettles of baked beans on Saturdays that would stay warm over the weekends. Our Guide will be taking us on a tour of the city highlights and then along the Freedom Trail. Our lunch will probably be at Quincy Market, with a wide selection of shops and entertainment. For those who wish to take a walking tour with our guide, you can do so to hear the “tale of the midnight ride of Paul Revere”. Wander the narrow streets of Boston’s North End and see the Old North Church, Paul Revere’s House, Copp’s Hill Burying Ground and the new England Holocaust memorial.
